5. New Business

AAPG DataPages (Peter Johnson)

- o AAPG DataPages are live as of Fall 2014.
- AGS receives the following revenue streams for sales of AGS publications on AAPG DataPages:
 - o Quarterly check for publications being in the archive
 - o 50% of sales for any sale of a single copy AGS publication
 - o 50% of sales for AGS CD/DVD
 - o 50% of sales from multiple society documents
 - A percentage based on hits on AGS publications. There are 440 AGS publications out of 84,000 documents
- AGS usually sells stratigraphic sections for an area, whereas currently AAPG sells individual stratigraphic sections. Single copy sheets need to have a cover sheet added to avoid being downloaded for free via Google searches.
- AAPG will provide quarterly reports to AGS on sales. Revenue received will depend on when AAPG subscribers pay (subscribers have different fiscal calendars).
- o There is no restriction on AGS selling its own documents.
- o AAPG can set its own prices for AGS publications.
- To access AAPG DataPages, go to <u>www.aapg.org</u>, select "Publications", select "DataPages Archives", click on the orange "Access DataPages Archives", and select "West Coast Group" Archives. Search for AGS publications by text, title, author, year, etc.
